League & Cup Competitions for 2025/2026

The committee had received a proposal from Stroud of 3 divisions, 1 division which we split at Christmas into a 1^{st} & 2^{nd} division, then we have 2 divisions from the start using last season's league positions.

The meeting discussed having 2 home games and 2 away games for each team before Christmas then 2 home and away after Christmas which would give us around 20/24 games. Some people thought this was quite a lot to fit in before Christmas and afterwards especially if we are having a cup competition.

The meeting also discussed having 3 games but that would mean that some people would be playing away more often.

No real decision was made on this and needs more discussion at the next meeting and is a priority to be discussed.

The meeting voted on the 3 different league formats that were proposed.

On the first vote the 3 divisions suggestion was voted out.

On the second vote the meeting decided on 2 divisions with promotion next season, using this year's league positions.

The meeting also decided that the GBBA will keep the same format for a minimum of 2 years, team numbers permitting The GBL may have a new team coming from Hartpury and there was a discussion with regard to what they would be like and what division they should be in.

Following this discussion it was agreed that they would be put in the 2^{nd} division.

Cup Competition - Emma suggested a one-day competition possibly in February maybe at Hartpury.

This would be a tournament format with a reduced court time with all teams being invited. The committee decided to discuss this further at a later meeting, but everyone thought this was a good idea.

If we have a one-day competition, with all teams present, this would encourage the community feeling.

The meeting decided that the league entries would be finalised by mid-July with a plan of getting fixtures out in August this would allow teams to plan and check if their venues have any planned closures.

League Rule Changes

Cass gave out a sheet to everyone with the proposed GBBA rule changes.

All these were accepted.

We also spoke about the penalties for technical and unsportsmanlike fouls.

Technical Fouls will continue to carry a points total of 3.

Unsportsmanlike Fouls will carry a points total of 2. Referees - We asked that the referees let Andy know if any of the above fouls are recorded as this makes it easier for us to open disciplinary hearing if players reach the points tally that triggers this.
